- TERMS OF SALE -

Opening time

Electrobeach Festival (« Electrobeach »)

Electrobeach will open each festival day (Friday, July 12, Saturday, July 13 and Sunday, July 14) from 3:30PM to 02:00AM the next day.

Please allow enough time for registration and your access to the site. After 11:00PM access to the site is no longer possible on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Camping Electrobeach ("GreenBeach")

To enter GreenBeach, you must purchase a Festival + GreenBeach pass. Check-in takes place at the places indicated on site between Thursday, July 11 at 10:00AM and Sunday, July 14 at 9:00PM. GreenBeach will be open from Thursday, July 11th at 10:00AM until Monday, July 15th at 6:00PM, after which you will not be allowed to re-enter GreenBeach.

ARTICLE 1: YOUR TICKET

- A. NOTE that the purchase of a Ticket for Electrobeach and/or GreenBeach constitutes express acceptance of being bound by all the terms and conditions of this contract (the "Contract") between the buyer and/or holder (hereinafter "You" or "Your") of the bracelet ("Ticket") and the SAEM Events Made in France ("Company") to attend all or part of the Electrobeach and/or access to GreenBeach (Electrobeach and/or GreenBeach, hereinafter referred to as "Event").
- B. For security reasons, the Company reserves the right, without notice or compensation for you:
- To postpone, cancel, interrupt or stop the Event.
 - Temporarily keep festival visitors on the event site at the end of the festival.
 - To evacuate totally or partially the site of the Event.
 - Deny access to the Event Site regardless of possession of a valid Entry Ticket.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE STATED IN THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE, YOU AGREE WITHOUT CONDITION THAT THE PURCHASE OF TICKETS IS CLOSED AND DEFINITIVE, THERE WILL BE NO REFUND / EXCHANGE OF TICKETS.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, if the Event is canceled in part due to force majeure, the Company may refund part of Your Ticket in the reasonable discretion of the Company, taking into account the extent of the cancellation between other considerations. A "Force Majeure Event" means a natural disaster, act of terrorism, flood, tsunami, strike or other condition or conflict of employment, an order or injunction of a court or administrative body or any other act of public authority, bad weather threatening the safety of participants in the Event or a similar event or unforeseen event, such occurrence beyond the reasonable control of the Company.

- A. You acknowledge and understand that the Ticket is a revocable license to attend the Event for

which it was issued. The Ticket is subject to revocation and refusal of admission without compensation for any reason, including, but not limited to Your attempt to violate or breach any of the rules set forth herein, but also for attempts violations or violations of all applicable laws and for the danger to other holders of Tickets.

- B. By entering the Event, You voluntarily assume all risks and dangers inherent in the Event whether before, during or after the Event, including death, injury, loss, damage or disability. For this reason, the Company recommends that you do not bring valuables to the Event.

ARTICLE 2: TICKET AND PROOF OF AGE REQUIRED

- A. To access the Event, You must have Your own valid Ticket. One Ticket per participant is required and will only be valid on the day or days of the Event and the Event zones as indicated on the Ticket.
- B. Your Ticket is not redeemable for cash. There is no replacement for Lost, Stolen, Destroyed or Damaged Tickets and **You unconditionally accept the risk of loss and/or theft of this Ticket.**
- C. To make sure your Ticket is valid, purchase your Tickets from authorized sales channels at www.electrobeach.com. Tickets sold from unauthorized sales channels (for example: street vendors...) may be falsified. Under no circumstances will fake Tickets be honored or eligible for a refund.
- D. You must present Your Ticket for validation upon entry into the Event.
- E. **Entrance to the Event is reserved for people over 16 years old.** You must be at least 16 years old on the day of the Event. Access to the VIP area is STRICTLY reserved for adults.
- F. You will need to be able to present proof that demonstrates proof of your age. No exceptions will be made, even if You are accompanied by an adult or a person in possession of a valid ID. Failure to provide valid proof will prevent You from entering the Event and You will not be entitled to any refund. In addition, You must be able to provide an ID upon request by a member of security or personnel. If You are not able to show a valid ID, you may be deported from the Event without receiving a refund of Your Ticket.
- G. **The originals of the following credentials are accepted to enter:**
- ID card
 - Passport
 - Driver's license
- H. **The following credentials are not acceptable for entering:**
- Expired identity card
 - Expired passport
 - School ID card
 - Birth certificate
 - Social security card
 - Voter's card
 - Photocopies of all proof of valid identities

ARTICLE 3: SECURITY CONTROLS

A. Access to the Event Site is prohibited or denied, but not limited to, those who:

- are clearly under the influence of alcohol, drugs or other illegal substances.
- have been banned from festivals previously either by the organizer, the administration or the judicial authorities.
- demonstrate intent to disturb the peace or cause someone else to do so.
- engage in combat or disruptive behavior.
- use foul language.
- wear clothes with obscene or indecent language.
- Refuse to be controlled and searched.
- refuse to declare and discard objects that are prohibited, as indicated below.
- distribute flyers or posters inside or outside the event site.
- violate one or more of the provisions of one or more articles of this by-law or in the spirit of this bylaw.

Please note that all ticket holders will be searched at the entrance to the event site. Security personnel will inspect all items brought to the Event site, including, but not limited to, clothing, baggage and other personal items for the purpose of detecting objects that may, or may be, used to disrupt the course of the event, endanger the safety of other Ticket holders or disturb the peace. Security personnel reserve the right to confiscate these objects at their sole discretion. Given the volume of participants, there is no guarantee that these objects will be returned. For this reason, please read carefully Article 4.

ARTICLE 4: OBJECTS PERMITTED AND PROHIBITED

A. The following objects are prohibited in the festival grounds:

- NO bag, water bag ...
- NO glass in any form whatsoever
- NOT cans
- NO weapons of any kind
- NO paint of any kind including aerosols
- NO fumigants, flares and flares, fireworks
- NO Venetian lantern
- NO illegal substances, drugs or drugs
- NO unpackaged medicines / vitamins
- NO prescription medication
- NOT big chains
- NO laser pointers
- NO dangerous flag masts
- NO big umbrellas
- NO unpackaged hygienic tampons
- NO pacifiers
- NO bikes, scooters, karts, or ATVs
- NO pet, leave your pets at home
- NO cooler
- NO food or drinks (1 bottle of sealed water allowed)
- NO Tupperware

- NO deodorant or perfume in the form of aerosol
- NO tripod
- NO projectiles or explosives
- NO knives or sharp objects
- NO flammable products or aerosols
- NO water guns or foggers
- NO chairs
- NO flyers, stickers, posters
- NO advertising flag, flag with political message
- NO drones

The following objects are prohibited at GreenBeach:

- NO glass in any form whatsoever
- NO weapons of any kind
- NO paint of any kind including aerosols
- NO lighters
- NO matches
- NO fireworks
- NO Venetian lantern
- NO illegal substances
- NO open fires
- NO charcoal barbecue
- NO charcoal
- NO gas tank
- NOT stuffed animals
- NO bikes, scooters, karts, or ATVs
- NO pet, leave your pets at home
- NO generator set
- NO gas
- NO drums
- NO laser pointers
- NO dangerous flag masts
- NO unpackaged hygienic tampons
- NO pacifiers
- NO deodorant or perfume in the form of aerosol
- NO unpackaged medicines / vitamins
- NO prescription medication
- NO projectiles or explosives
- NO knives
- NO flammable products or aerosols
- NO flyers, stickers, posters
- NO drones
- NO open fires
- NO more per person:
 - A crate of beer (maximum size of 6x33cl)
 - **OR** 1L of wine
 - **OR** 50cl of strong alcohol
- At the sole discretion of the Event staff: Anything that can be used as a means to disturb the peace, endanger the safety of the crowd and/or inflict damage to people and property.

B. You can bring:

- Digital and / or disposable camera and camera (non-professional)
- Plastic tarps and blankets to sit
- Sunscreen and cosmetics (max 90ml)
- Sunglasses
- Small or medium backpacks (no more than 53cm high x 25cm wide x 35cm deep)
- Flags
- Mobile phones
- Reusable water bottles (must be empty or sealed at the entrance)
- Sunglasses, hats, fanny packs
- Sealed Chewing Gum Package
- Sealed lipstick
- Empty camelback

ARTICLE 5: BEHAVIOR AT THE EVENT

A. At the Event, it is forbidden to:

- Try to access or be in reserved areas that are not allowed to you.
- Climb on tents, constructions, fences, closures, lighting columns, tables, benches or any other infrastructure of the Event site.
- Interfering with entrances, exits and escape routes and / or lingering at these locations for longer than strictly necessary to enter or exit the site.
- Wear a disguise or outfit that prevents you from seeing your face or identifying yourself.
- At the sole discretion of security personnel or staff Event: display or broadcast text, symbols, images, gestures, wear clothing in obscene, racist, xenophobic, provocative or discriminatory language.
- Be clearly under the influence of alcohol, drugs or other illegal substances.
- Disturb the peace, demonstrate an intention to disturb the peace or cause someone else to do so, or compromise the safety of the general public.
- Sell food or any other product without the express consent of the Company.
- Throw or shoot with any object or liquid.
- Smoking in non-smoking areas.
- Urinate in public.
- Enter the Event again after being expelled or banned from the Event, even if You are in possession of a new Ticket (these Tickets will not be refunded).
- Make illegible, mark, damage, demolish or destroy, in whole or in part, any of the decorations.
- Do not contribute to the cleanliness of the event site by throwing rubbish out of the trash.
- Resist instructions and searches ordered by security personnel.
- Refuse to report and dispose of items that are considered hazardous by Event security personnel - security personnel are not required to return confiscated items.
- Act in violation of the provisions of one or more articles of this bylaw or the spirit thereof.

B. You must take into account the indications of the organizers of the Event and the staff security at all times throughout the event site. If You do not comply with these instructions, You will be evicted from the Event Site, and, if necessary, the Event staff may seek help from the police.

ARTICLE 6: ENTRY AND EXIT

- A. It is not possible to enter and exit the Event several times. Ticket holders leaving the Event must purchase a new Ticket to re-enter the Event.
- B. If You are expelled from the Event, Your Ticket will not be refunded and You will not be able to re-enter the festival grounds even if You are in possession of a new Ticket. If You have a new Ticket, the Event staff may enter this Ticket without refund.

ARTICLE 7: SALE OR UNLAWFUL USE OF TICKETS

- A. Anyone caught with fake tickets to access or sell will be prosecuted without exception. Counterfeit Tickets will not be honored or reimbursed by the Company.
- B. Any person taken with a falsified Ticket or exchanging it will be immediately expelled and banned from the Event.
- C. Tickets may not be resold without the express prior permission of the Company. Tickets resold without permission of the Company will not be valid at the entrance of the site and will not be refunded.
- D. Resale, attempted resale, or ticket purchase at a higher price than the official purchase price listed on www.electrobeach.com is a reason for seizure and cancellation without compensation.
- E. Tickets may not be used in conjunction with games, including but not limited to prizes or awards, without the prior written consent of the Company. Any ticket thus used will automatically become void at the sole discretion of the Company without refund to you and / or the ticket holder.

ARTICLE 8: CHECK-IN

- A. By attending the Event, You give Your express consent that You may be photographed and filmed and that such images may be recorded, stored, broadcast, rebroadcast, and sold for commercial purposes. Your image may also be used on any live screen or video broadcast system or for reproduction in whole or in part of the Event as in movies, photographs, audios and / or audiovisual recording may be used for promotional and / or commercial purposes by the Company or a third party.
- B. At the Event, there will be surveillance cameras to ensure the safety and proper functioning of the Event. These images may be stored and reviewed by the police and / or Event staff to ensure compliance with and compliance with all laws, rules and regulations on the Event Site.
- C. Registrations made by Ticket Holders on or near the Event Site may not be used for commercial or public purposes except with the consent of the Company.

ARTICLE 9: GREENBEACH TICKET

- A. The Greenbeach Ticket is valid only in combination with a Festival Ticket.
- B. The Greenbeach Ticket is valid for the duration of its opening. There is no ticket 1 day.

- C. The Greenbeach Ticket is valid per person and not per tent.
- D. In the event of the loss or theft of a Greenbeach Ticket, the Tickets will not be refunded or replaced.
- E. The Greenbeach Ticket secures a campsite at one of the Greenbeach areas. No reservation is possible.
- F. The following items are not allowed in Greenbeach: cars, motorcycles, trailers, caravans, mobile homes, and others.

ARTICLE 10: MERCHANDISING

- A. Official merchandising is only sold on the Event site and/or on the website www.electrobeach.com.

ARTICLE 11: PARKING

- A. All vehicles on regulated parking lots must be equipped with a parking sticker, issued by the Company upon access. Offenders will be towed at their expense. The Company declines all responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles parked on or near the Event. The Company is not liable for any loss or damage to any vehicle towed from the Event site.

ARTICLE 12: WASTE

- A. Electrobeach and Greenbeach are located in a natural area. You must maintain the cleanliness of the event site and dispose of the waste properly. Collection points for waste and recycling at the Event site will be clearly indicated. You can also find garbage cans in the car parks.
- B. Toilets are free at Electrobeach and GreenBeach. It is forbidden to use any other place as sanitary installation.

ARTICLE 13: ZERO POLICY ON THE USE OF DRUGS

- A. The Company has a zero tolerance policy on drugs. It is forbidden to use, distribute, sell and / or to be in possession of drugs on the site of the Event. If You are in violation of this rule, You will be immediately expelled from the Event site. Event staff will closely monitor any potential drug activity, including security cameras placed through the event site.
- B. Before entering the event site, You may throw the drugs in Your possession in bins provided for this purpose, throwing them in these bins You will have no pursuit.
- C. When entering the event site, you agree to be searched by festival staff. If You refuse to submit to a search by the security personnel of the Event, entry to the site will be refused.

ARTICLE 14: PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES AND REDUCED MOBILITY

- A. Parking spaces are reserved for access You will need to submit proof: disability card ...

- B. At the main entrance, there will be a wheelchair accessible ticket booth.
- C. Guide dogs are allowed on the event site. Please, thank you for making them easily recognizable as such
- D. Adapted toilets are located in different places of the Event site.
- E. Reduced Mobility: The event site is wheelchair accessible, but be aware that the Event is outdoors and the typology of the grounds maybe binding. Although we do our best to provide adequate routes, most trips are made on natural ground: grass, sand ... In case of rain, the soil may be soft and mud may be in some places.
- F. Some Event staff are designated to assist with accessibility and can be found at the entrance of the Event or called at the Information Kiosk, which is also near the Event entrance.

ARTICLE 15: MEDICAL ATTENTION

- A. You hereby agree to receive medical attention and to be transported for the purpose of obtaining treatment in case of injury that the Event, Safety, Police or health professionals may deem appropriate. their reasonable discretion.
- B. You hereby agree to release and compensate the "Parties to the Company" (defined below) for all liabilities in connection with acts or omissions relating to your medical care.
- C. You acknowledge and acknowledge that there are dangers and risks of physical injury or illness and that all of these risks cannot be completely eliminated. By entering the Event Site, You voluntarily agree to assume the entire risk of death, personal injury or property damage, regardless of the severity, that would result from attendance at the Event or on the spot, caused or not by the negligence or gross negligence of the organizers or their agents.

ARTICLE 16: INDEMNITY

- A. You hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Company, the Parent Company, its affiliates and subsidiaries, and their representatives, officers, officers, owners, members, administrators, agents, employees, successors and assigned (the "Parties of the Company") in the event of loss, obligation, damage, or expense, as a result of or in connection with any negligence or improper conduct on your part, in or around the Event or during Your trip to and from the Event.
- B. You unburden and hold harmless the Parties of the Company, by waiving and promising not to sue them, in relation to any liability arising out of or in connection with the Event, for any disputes, motives or grounds actions, obligations, lawsuits, charges, claims, disagreements, damages, costs or experiences, of any type, nature or description, whether direct or indirect, in law or equity, contractual or prejudicial, or otherwise, than they are known or unknown, occurring during or in connection with the Event or Your presence at the Event or Your trip to or from the Event, whether or not caused by negligence or negligence of the Parties to the Company.
- C. You unreservedly agree that the terms and conditions set forth herein and / or referred to herein represent the entire agreement between You and the Ticket issuer in relation to its contents, and that they cancel and replace all agreements, communications and understandings, written or verbal, previously existing in relation to said content and that would contradict the terms of the

present, including, but not limited to the text printed on the back of the issued Note, and / or any agreement or contrary agreement between You and the Company.

- D. You unconditionally agree to be bound by all terms and conditions set forth herein and / or referred to herein, as well as any additions, changes and / or modifications made to them.
- E. The terms of these presents shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws in force in France. Any dispute or claim arising out of or relating to these terms shall be heard only in the courts of the venue of the Event, unless otherwise specified. The parties hereto expressly agree to the personal jurisdiction of such courts.

ARTICLE 17: INTRODUCTION OF FOOD AND DRINKS TO GREENBEACH

- A. Electrobeach has always allowed customers to bring alcohol from the outside into the GreenBeach compound. However, Electrobeach producers retain the rights to limit the amount of alcohol you can bring to GreenBeach. If an alcohol limit is decided, You agree to honor all procedures developed by the producers of the Event and to adopt these limitations. In addition, if you bring alcohol beyond the limitations, you agree to throw away excess alcohol, or otherwise you will not be allowed to enter GreenBeach.

ARTICLE 18: GREENBEACH

- A. GreenBeach is strictly reserved for tents. Vehicles can not access inside the GreenBeach compound. The tents must be occupied by the number of persons of which it has capacity. If you have a tent with a capacity of 6 people, 6 people will have to be inside it. GreenBeach staff reserves the right to refuse entry or to advise you of Your tent placement if You do not comply with the above rules. By purchasing this Ticket, You agree to the terms above and the future terms and conditions provided by the Company.
